They fund thru limited private and public grants and provide direct project services by working with organizations to donate services for advertising.

They are committed to working in particular with low income families but that does not mean this service is not available to anyone in your community. The UPS Foundation presented Laurie Ackerman, the development director a check for \$12,000 to provide equipment within public libraries in any area of need to help enhance the ability for one to read a book or allow the privacy to read their own materials. The Public Library system doesn't always have the funds necessary to obtain this type of special equipment. In addition, as their name states "Sound", they have a hearing aid service. Most medical coverage's do not provide coverage for this service, so Sight and Sound again have made arrangements with doctors and one of largest hearing aid manufacturers to make it possible for others to obtain that special gift of hearing once again.
